## Archery Patch

The Archery Patch program is intended to be fun, increase self-confidence through learning a new skill, and recognize knowledge and proficiency in the sport of target archery.

Participation is open to Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors and Ambassadors (Re *Safety-Wise*, page 59).

Complete all four requirements.

1. Demonstrate a working knowledge of range safety.
2. Know the equipment.
  - A. Identify and describe the recurve bow and the compound bow.
  - B. Identify at least five (5) bow parts from this list:

1) Face	6) Arrow rest
2) Back	7) Recurve
3) Tip	8) Limbs
4) Handle	9) String
5) Nocking point	
  - C. Identify at least three arrow parts from this list:

1) Point	4) Index feather
2) Shaft	5) Nock
3) Fletching	6) Cresting
3. Shoot at least 50 rounds.
4. At a distance of 30 feet, hit a three-foot diameter target at least 8 out of 10 times.
