2. Graduating High School Senior in Girl Scouts of Middle Tennessee Council area. Home School applicants are welcome.
3. Must earn the Gold Award in Girl Scouts by May 2012.
4. Currently registered with Girl Scouts of Middle Tennessee Council.
5. Plans to attend an accredited college or university.
6. Submission of completed application within time guidelines.

**The following items must be completed, postmarked no later than 3-31-2012, and submitted to Medical Billing Alternatives, LLC for consideration:**

1. Application
2. Essay Answers, either typed or written legibly.
3. Letter from school authority or copy of current report card in order to verify GPA.
4. Letter from Girl Scout Leader or Council in order to verify current enrollment and Gold Award achievement.
5. Name of accredited college or university to which you have been accepted.
6. Letter of recommendation from someone who **you** perceive to be "outstanding".
