*The girls additionally spent time on computers learning about water conservation. While building awareness of the water cycle, the girls agreed to work toward a personal goal of remembering to turn the water off while brushing their teeth in order to save water.*

*A seeming small goal, the awareness of how much water would be saved in a year prompted the response, "I didn't know I was wasting so much".*

*One Girl Scout mom shared the story about her daughter Cassidy's experience at Camp Music City, a program in which girls get behind-the-scenes access to concerts, autograph and interview sessions in order to gain insight to the variety of musical careers available and the skills, hard work and determination needed to be as successful as Nashville's big stars.*

*"Cassidy has always had an interest in music and has a gift for it. When I saw this event I knew it would be a perfect fit. Nervous about being around new people and being in a new place, she was reluctant to go...*

*It was the best event she has attended since we moved to Tennessee! She found people with common interests, common backgrounds and they soon shared memories to last a lifetime. Not only was the event planned well, a fantastic staff and counselors were on board.*

*Bonding and sisterhood grew between the girls in Girl Scout Fit Club, a program designed for girls that increases awareness about healthy choices.*

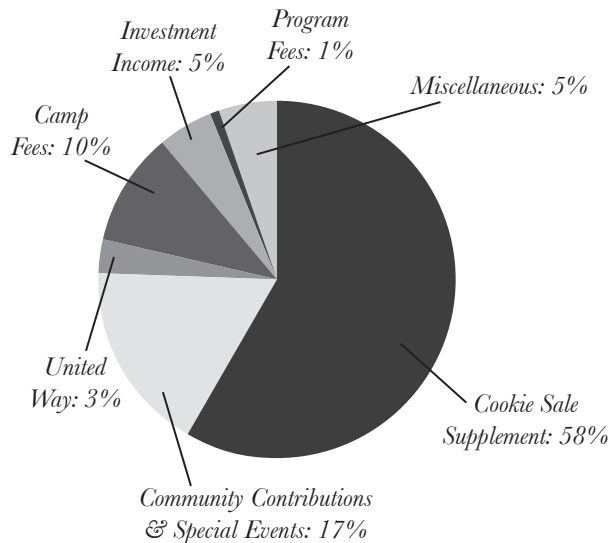

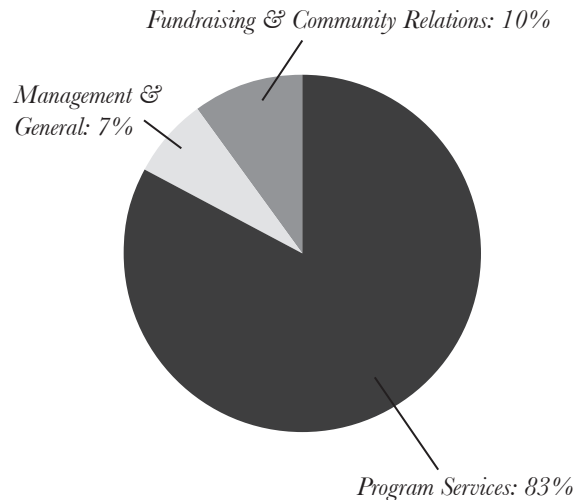
# 2008 - 2009 OPERATING REVENUE\*
