HORSE DAY CAMPS

Bring your group for a day with the horses. This day-long program includes: riding lessons, games on horseback and learning how to get a horse ready to ride. Groups must sign-up with a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 12 riders. Participants will bring a sack lunch, drinks and snacks for the day. Adults are not required to stay, but are welcome.

TRAIL RIDE

In the case of inclement weather or unsafe trail conditions, alternate arena activities will be substituted.

VAQUERAS TRAINING DAY
