Rolled Paper Flower Art

What can you make with a simple strip of paper!

What will I need?

- Craft Glue (E600/gorilla glue/hot glue)
- Fast-drying glue (tacky glue/hot glue)
- Colored paper (card stock preferred)
- Picture frame
- Optional: paper crimper

Parents corner

If hot glue is used try to use a low temp hot glue gun or help use the glue gun with younger girls.



Where should I go?

This activity should be completed at a table on top of a news paper or tray because glue can get messy.



What do I already know?

1. What type of Medium are you using in this activity?

2. Can you name another type of art & crafts projects that uses paper?

3. Why is it important to make a plan?



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut your paper into ¼ inch strips
- 2. Crimp half of your paper strips with either the paper crimper or by hand folding the paper strips back and forth like an accordion.
- 3. Tightly roll each strip of paper and secure with a dot of glue until you have a large pile
- 4. Arrange your rolls of paper as you wish on the cardboard in the frame.
- 5. Glue down all your rolls with your fast-drying glue.





What did I learn?

1. Why would you NOT want to use super glue or another quick drying glue when placing your paper rolls on the cardboard?

2. How do you make flowers larger? Flowers smaller?

1. What else could you make with this technique?
