#### In the next week:

- Complete Girl Scouting 101 (gsmidtn.org)
- Completing Youth Protection (gsmidtn.org)
- Choose meeting day/time and location PRIOR to meeting with the parents
- Build your troop team (have parents sign up to lead meetings, bring snack, coordinate the Cookie season, have a troop job ,etc.)
- Host parent meeting
  - Collect uniform orders
  - Collect troop dues
  - Collect health history forms (required)

#### In the next 2 weeks:

- Apply for tax exemption status
- Your Regional Executive will reach out to with information on setting up the troop bank account
- Ensure all Girl Scouts are registered online (you can view your roster on CouncilAlignMENT  $\rightarrow$  troop management  $\rightarrow$  troop roster)

#### In the next month:

- Attend your first service unit meeting
- Purchase uniforms for troop

#### In the next 6 months:

- Someone who will attend every troop meeting should be certified in CPR/AED/ First Aid
- o Attend a service unit or council-sponsored event
