Sweet Support for Girl Scouts of Middle Tennessee's Troop 6000

NASHVILLE, TENN. – February XX, 2021 - In August 2017, Girl Scouts of Middle Tennessee (GSMIDTN) launched Troop 6000, an initiative that serves girls without permanent housing, modeled after similar troops launched in New York City.

Like all Girl Scouts, Troop 6000 participates in badge earning, outdoor experiences, community service, and Girl Scout traditions including the Girl Scout Cookie Program.

During this year's unprecedented pandemic, GSMIDTN created an [online cookie fulfillment system](#) for far-away customers or for those that may not visit in-person booths this year. While some troops are still setting up in-person cookie booths, Troop 6000's cookie program takes place exclusively online this year.

With all of their proceeds staying local, girls in Troop 6000 are able to enjoy a fully funded Girl Scout experience. Girls even have the opportunity to use their cookie season proceeds to attend summer camp or take part in exciting Girl Scout Programs.

Supporters can purchase Girl Scout Cookies from Troop 6000 on the Girl Scouts of Middle Tennessee [website](#) until March 1. Traditional flavors such as Samoas, Tagalongs, Thin Mints, Trefoils, Lemon-Ups, and Do-si-dos will be \$4 a box, and specialty flavors of Girl Scout S'mores and Toffee-Tastic are \$5.50 a box.
