All applications should be received by May 8, 2021. All fees must be paid with the application. Full refunds may be requested until May 6, 2021. After 5/6/2021, campers who are unable to attend will receive a link to the virtual camp information.

What to wear: T-shirts, shorts or pants, head gear (cap or bandanna), over the ankle socks, and tennis shoes. **NO HALTER TOPS, TANK TOPS, CROP TOPS, CROCS, OR SANDALS.** There may be days where we hike or play games in the grass area. Those without the proper clothing will not be allowed to join in those activities.

What to bring: Refillable water bottle, sunscreen, and bug repellent. Please put child's name on all items.

Meals. A "brown bag"/sack-type dinner will be provided by camp on Monday - Thursday and some days may also include snacks. If your child has **any food allergies**, please be sure they are listed on the Health History form.

Medications. Any medications brought to camp **MUST** be in the original prescription bottle with the dosage/dispensing instructions listed. Place this bottle in a zip lock bag with the child's name clearly marked on it. These meds must be given to the camp nurse/first aider every day upon arrival.

Camp begins each day 4:30pm sharp. Campers may start arriving by 4:15 pm. Campers will be dismissed **after** closing ceremony at 8:30 pm on Monday-Thursday and at 6:30pm on Friday. Parents, please wait in the designated area until the girls are dismissed.
